MIDDLESEX COUNTY CRICKET LEAGUE – FACILITIES REQUIREMENTS 2023

Overview

This document has been prepared to assist clubs in understanding the requirements, expectations and preferences for the playing of 1^{st} & 2^{nd} XI cricket within the MCCL.

The MCCL are proud of the diversity of our league, and will work with clubs and the Playing and Grounds Sub-Committee, to improve the standard of playing facilities across our county, and to get the game on.

Please note that all criteria in this document are subject to special dispensation. For special dispensation to be granted, an action plan will need to be submitted to Chair of the Playing & Grounds Sub-Committee.

<u>Promotion Requirements & Decision-Making Process</u>

This document is managed by the MCCL Playing & Grounds Sub-Committee in conjunction with the MCCL Executive. All clubs are encouraged to maintain effective communication channels with the league and its officials.

Promotion from Division 4 to Division 3, and from Division 1 to Premier League, will only be confirmed if all items required at the higher division have been achieved by the end of the current (promotion) season. The MCCL Executive are currently in the process of determining appropriate sanctions for non-compliance with these criteria.

Penalties

Points penalties may apply to clubs in circumstances where the League Executive believe that warnings with regards to their facilities have not been heeded / actioned upon.

Pitch marking points penalties are detailed below:

Premier League (pitch mark required 31):

- If average score is 30.5 or higher warning
- If average score is between 28.5 and 30.5 10 point penalty at the start of the following season.
- If average score is less than 28.5 points penalty TBC by MCCL Executive
- If average score is less than 24.8 (20% away from the level prescribed for the division), penalty at the discretion of the MCCL Executive, up to and including relegation by one division.

Outside Premier League (pitch mark required 28):

- If average score is 27.5 or higher warning
- If average score is between 25.5 and 27.5 10 point penalty at the start of the following season.
- If average score is less than 25.5 points penalty TBC by MCCL Executive
- If average score is less than 22.4 (20% away from the level prescribed for the division), penalty at the discretion of the MCCL Executive, up to and including relegation by one division.
